
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ORDER SUMMARILY  
SUSPENDING REGISTRATION

Pursuant to G.S. § 150B-3(c) and 21 N.C.A.C. 46.2006(b), the North Carolina Board of Pharmacy ("Board"), vis Members Rebecca W. Chater, L. Stan Haywood, J. Parker Chesson, Jr., Betty H. Dennis, Wallace E. Nelson and Joey McLaughlin, Jr. find that the protection of the public health, safety and welfare requires emergency action. Accordingly, the Board hereby Summarily Suspends Registration No. 08499 issued to Christopher Crowl ("Respondent Crowl"), effective upon service of this Order. Respondent Crowl shall immediately cease any practice of pharmacy in North Carolina pending issuance by the Board of a Final Agency Decision.

A hearing before the Board regarding the charges against Respondent Crowl shall be conducted on February 19, 2008, at the Board's office located at 6015 Farrington Road, Suite 201, Chapel Hill, North Carolina. If Respondent Crowl wishes to appear before the Board at this meeting, Respondent Crowl shall notify the Board's Executive Director in writing within ten (10) days of receiving service of this Order, after which the Board will serve Respondent Crowl with a Notice of Hearing in accordance with G.S. § 150B-38(b).


