Pursuant to the provisions of North Carolina General Statutes §§ 93B-13 and 110-142.1 and pursuant to the Notice of Intent to Suspend Registration dated January 8, 2008, Technician Steven B. McKinnon was notified that his name had been placed on a certified list as being in non-compliance with certain child-support-related obligations. Mr. McKinnon was further notified that the Board intended to suspend his registration and to refuse to renew his registration to practice as a technician twenty days from the date of the Notice. That Notice was served upon Mr. McKinnon on January 19, 2008.

The North Carolina Board of Pharmacy considered evidence and determined that the Mr. McKinnon who is listed in the certified notice provided by the designated representative of the Department of Health and Human Services is the same person as the Mr. McKinnon who is a technician registered with the North Carolina Board of Pharmacy.

The North Carolina Board of Pharmacy has not been informed by the Department of Health and Human Services, pursuant to the procedure established in North Carolina General Statutes § 110-142.1, that Mr. McKinnon has sought review of his child support case. Further, the North Carolina Board of Pharmacy has not been informed that Mr. McKinnon has negotiated a payment schedule approved by the child support enforcement agency. Finally, the North Carolina Board of Pharmacy has not been informed that Mr. McKinnon has obtained a certificate of compliance to be provided to the Board before the date of suspension set forth in the Notice.


Because twenty days have elapsed since the date of the Notice of Intent to Suspend Registration, the North Carolina Board of Pharmacy hereby ORDERS that the license of Steven B. McKinnon is SUSPENDED until such time as the Board receives certification, pursuant to the procedure established in North Carolina General Statutes § 110-142.1, that Mr. McKinnon is not in default of his child-support-related obligations.

As set forth in the Notice, the Board is not required to refund fees paid by Mr. McKinnon for his registration.
