Patti Padgett was issued technician registration number 21132 by the North Carolina Board of Pharmacy on January 7, 2008 and renewed annually thereafter.


Ms. Padgett admits that while working as a registered technician with Wal-Mart Pharmacy, #7977, located at 1130 S. Main St. Kernersville, NC 277284, she committed acts that give the Board sufficient cause to revoke her technician registration.

Considering that, Ms. Padgett voluntarily surrenders her technician registration. The surrender of the registration is made voluntarily and without pressure, coercion, or the threat of force being made against her. As a result of the voluntary surrender, Ms. Padgett shall not be present in any pharmacy in any capacity other than as a customer/patient, with a valid prescription from a treating physician, unless and until the Board issues any further order.

Ms. Padgett understands and accepts that, at any point in the future, she may petition for reinstatement by submitting a request to the Board of Pharmacy, in writing. Upon a request for reinstatement, the Board will determine within sixty (60) days when it will schedule a hearing on the request for reinstatement. That hearing will be scheduled at the Board's discretion. There is no presumption, guarantee or other implication intended within this document that the Board will reinstate the registration.


The decision will be made by the Board based on consideration of all available evidence presented at a formal hearing before the Board. The registration will not be returned until and unless the Board issues a reinstatement order after any formal hearing.
