



4. Following that interview, Ms. VanHoozen entered into a monitoring contract with the North Carolina Pharmacist Recovery Network ("PRN"). Representatives of PRN have stated that Ms. VanHoozen is currently in compliance with her monitoring contract and that PRN advocates for her continued practice as a pharmacy technician at this time.

#### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The evidence demonstrates that Ms. VanHoozen violated one or more of the following statutes and rules:

- a. North Carolina General Statutes § 90-85.15A(d)(3) and (5);
- b. North Carolina General Statutes § 90-106(e); and
- c. North Carolina General Statutes § 90-108(a)(7).

2. Considering all of the facts and circumstances of this matter, the Board finds and concludes that the discipline set forth in this Consent Order is appropriate.

WHEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Ms. VanHoozen's continued holding of a technician registration is hereby subject to the following conditions:

1. Ms. VanHoozen shall fully comply with and successfully complete the full term of a PRN contract (as extended or shortened in the discretion of PRN) that, in the judgment of PRN, is adequate to assure that Ms. VanHoozen can safely assist a pharmacist in preparing and dispensing prescription medications.

2. Ms. VanHoozen shall advise the Board promptly in writing of any change of address or change in practice status.

3. Ms. VanHoozen shall violate no laws governing the practice of pharmacy or the distribution of drugs.

4. Ms. VanHoozen shall violate no rules or regulations of the Board.

If Ms. VanHoozen fails to comply with any terms or conditions of this Order, she shall be subject to additional discipline.

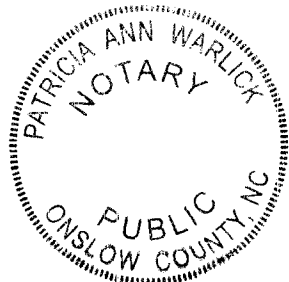
